At the centerpiece of the launch, artist Jane Dickson, in collaboration with Crash, will reimagine her seminal 1980 Fashion Moda installation, City Maze. One of the gallery's most iconic works, the maze was a space where local youth could explore and play in a symbolic urban labyrinth. This new City Maze will revive the spirit of the original South Bronx experiment - an immersive, interactive environment born from the energy of the streets. COME GET LOST!
